# Important Reminders!!

- Safety concerns have increased dramatically over the past couple of years due to children rushing into the street to pick up candy. The Oktoberfest parade permits candy distribution, **HOWEVER it must be given out by people walking along side of the entry. Throwing candy from floats or vehicles is not permitted and if parade entries do not do a better job of complying with this rule, giving out candy will not be permitted in future parades.**
- **Horses in the parade must be bagged**, or be accompanied by a scooper in order to be considerate of other parade entries. **Horses must also stay off of private lawns.** We reserve the right to dismiss riders/horses that do not follow these rules.
- Due to the challenges of lining up Marching Bands and units playing music with proper space intervals, please contact the parade director if you wish to play music at 754-5678 or 641-691-1183.
- Entries received are lined up by category in the order that they are received, therefore if an early parade position is desirable; please mail your entry early.
- Measure carefully!! Our parade has outgrown the current line-up area making correct measurements of your parade entries very important. Please measure accurately, if the length estimate needs to be revised after your original submission of your entry, please contact Cindy at 754-5678 or 641-691-1183
